OVERVIEW

Both, globally and in Ethiopia, BMZ is one of Welthungerhilfe's most important and reliable donors. The first project was funded in India in 1976. Currently, 52 projects are under implementation globally with a total budget volume of 78-million Euros on global level

The collaboration between BMZ and the Country Office in Ethiopia started more than 2 decades ago. In the past five years, together with our local partners, we have implemented and still implementing eight (8) projects with a total budget of 13,858,439 € out of which five projects in Afar, Amhara, and Oromia regions are still active.

In Somaliland, the collaboration started in 2001. In the past five years, we have implemented four projects with a total budget of 5,662,087 € in Boroma, Awdal and Falbeed regions.

PROJECTS IN ETHIOPIA

Afar region:

Project title: Promotion of maternal & reproductive health in remote communities of the Afar Pastoralist society (ETH 1136)

- Sector: Nutrition
- Duration: September 2015-June 2019
- Budget: 666,665 €
- Location: Afar region, Dubte, Afdeera, Bidu, Erbti and Magaale districts
- Targeted group: 24,200 women
- The objective of the project has been the promotion of women's health in remote areas of Afar Region

Strengthening the resilience capacity of pastoralists and agro-pastoralists in Afar Region, Ethiopia (ETH 1145)

- Sector: Agriculture & Environment, WASH, Economic development
- Duration: November 2016-December 2021
- Budget: 3, 111. 111 €
- Location: Afar region, Dubti woreda-Mille and Eli Daar woredas
- Targeted group: 54, 410 pastoralist/agro-pastoralists people
- The objective of the project is to strengthen resilience of the target households and reduce vulnerability of 54, 410 individuals in the districts.

Land for Life-Making Policies for Food Security work

- Sector: Civil Society, Empowerment
- Budget: 2,000.000 €
- Duration: May 2017-December 2019 (2nd phase about to start)
- Germany, Sierra Leone, Liberia, Burkina Faso and Ethiopia
- Targeted group: 80 civil society leaders f
- The objective of the project is to stop land grabbing and to make agricultural investments work for food security.

Oromia region:

Global Drought resilience cross border project to enhance the resilience capacities of pastoralist and agro-pastoralists residing in cross-border region of Kenya, Uganda and Ethiopia (ETH 1156)

- Sector: Rural and regional developments
- Duration: December 2017-December 2020

- Location: Kenya, Uganda and Ethiopia
- Budget: 1,171.970 € (Ethiopian component)
- Targeted group: 6,600 families
- The objective of the project is to Improve well-being and food and nutrition security of agro-pastoralist communities in arid and semi-arid of Ethiopia, Kenya and Uganda

In Amhara Region

Project title: Moving Towards Achieving Sustainable Food and Nutrition Security in the Highlands of Amhara (ETH 1161)

- Sector: Agriculture and Environment/ Rural and Regional development
- Duration: December 01, 2018-December 31, 2021
- Location: Amhara Regional State, Estie, Farta, Fogera and Guna-Begemidir Woredas
- Budget: 2, 146,667 €
- Targeted group: 61, 255 individuals
- The objective of the project is to contribute to the sustainable reduction of hunger and malnutrition in the region.



Linking Agriculture with natural Resource Management and Nutrition (LANN+) (ETH 1169)

- Sector: Agriculture & Environment, Nutrition, WASH, Economic Development, Civil Society, Empowerment
- Duration: December 2019-December 2023
- Location: Amhara Region, East Gojam Zone
- Target group: 36, 500 individuals
- Budget: . 2,000,000 Euro
- To contribute to the effort of Amhara region to end hunger & malnutrition by 2030.



Improving the Food and Nutrition Security of Coffee Farmers in Mana, Seka and Gomma District (ETH 1153)

- Sector: Agriculture, & Environment, Nutrition, Water, Sanitation and Hygiene, Economic development
- Duration: September 2017-April 2020
- Location: Oromia Region Jimma- Mana, Seka and Gomma district
- Budget: 1,600,000€
- Target group: 10, 000 coffee farmer families
- The objective of the project is to contribute to improved living conditions of smallholder coffee farmers and other particularly vulnerable groups (e.g. Women) in the Jimma Zone, Oromia Regional State.
